In-home (1 or 2 days, including on-call overnight) Victorian state-wide Occupational Therapy Support & Intervention

Services available include:

Initial visit:

Two days (48 hours) in-home, school, and community Occupational Therapy support and education, including 2 nights on-call availability in the child's home environment. Day 1: Assessment and observation with introduction of strategies. Day 2: Full implementation of strategies.

Cost: \$1500 (private rate, within 3 hour radius of Seymour, Victoria. Remote rate available). That's effectively 48 hours at an equivalent cost of 8 to 12 hours of assessment and intervention!

Follow-up visit:

One day (24 hours) in-home, school, and community Occupational Therapy review, to assist with consolidating and/or modifying strategies. Includes 1 night on-call availability in the child's home environment.

Cost: \$800 (private rate, within 3 hour radius of Seymour, Victoria. Remote rate available). That's effectively 24 hours at an equivalent cost of 4.5 to 6.5 hours of assessment and intervention!
