CURRICULUM DAY LAST DAY OF TERM 1

Friday 4th April will be a pupil free day. This Curriculum day will be an opportunity for staff to plan for the following term. As previously stated, the last day of swimming is the week before on Friday 28th March.

ABSENTEE REASON

It is an expectation of the State Government (Department of Education, and Early Childhood Development) that school record a reason for your child's absence. If your child is away either give a quick phone call or send note to let us know your child will not be at school for the day **and a reason why**. If you do not give us a reason the absence is recorded as "unapproved" and the new legislation in place includes a fine for parents whose children are away from school for a number of days without a legitimate reason given to the school.

CHILDREN LEAVING SCHOOL GROUNDS AT 3.30PM DISMISSAL

Parents must let us know when collecting children from the school when their child is normally a bus traveller. We must account for all students at the end of the day and have a record on the bus on which they travel.

If you have made arrangements **with another parent for your child to go to their home for a party or play etc, either by bus or car, it is vital that you notify us**. We will not let your child go with another parent or on a different bus unless we have been notified. It is NOT OK for the children to tell us "Mum said", we must hear from the parents ourselves.
