AROUND the CLASSES

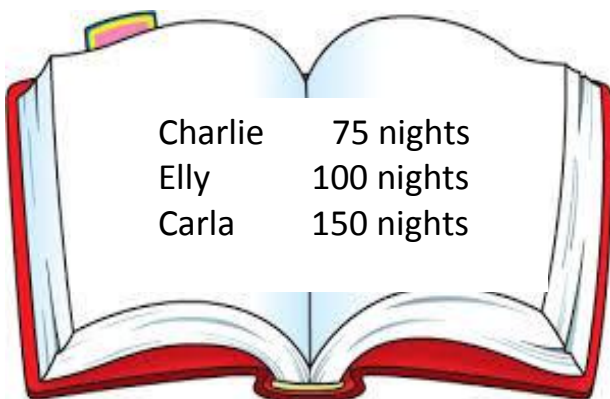
